Registration Fee	\$40 for the first two family members
Tuition	Price varies for how many classes you take! The more classes; the more of a discount!
	Sibling discounts: 10% for the first sibling; 15% for each additional sibling
	Tuition is due on the 1 st of the month
	Late fees - \$15 will be applied after 14 days past the due date
	August tuition will not be prorated; June tuition will be half your normal tuition cost
	If the 1 st is not a week day, and you need to pay in person instead of through the portal, it is your responsibility to pay your tuition before the due date to avoid late fees.

Class/Studio Expectations

To ensure a fun, safe, productive environment for everyone, we ask all students to follow these expectations during class:

1. Be Prepared and On Time

- Arrive 5-10 minutes before class
- Wear appropriate dance attire and bring required shoes
- o Hair should be neatly secured away from the face.

2. Show Respect

- o Listen to your instructors and classmates
- Keep a positive attitude and be kind to everyone
- o Follow studio rules and treat the space and equipment with care.

3. Stay Focused and Participate

- o Pay attention during instruction and try your best in every activity.
- o Ask questions if you don't understand! Learning is part of the process.
- o Avoid distracting behavior like talking out of turn. No phones allowed inside the classroom!

4. Practice Good Hygiene and Etiquette

- o Bring a water bottle into every class and stay hydrated.
- No gum, food, or drinks (besides water) in the studio.
- o Clean up after yourself and keep personal belongings organized.

5. Support Each Other

- Celebrate progress including yours and others!
- o Remember that every dancer learns at their own pace.
- o Encourage a team spirit and a safe, judgement-free space.

Dance Class Attire

To maintain a safe and comfortable classroom, students are expected to wear proper dance attire for each class style.

All classes: **Hair must be out of the face and secured** (ponytail, bun, pigtails, etc), **no jewelry** (stud earrings only), and **labeled shoes/clothing** with dancer's name.

 - Leotard (any color)
 - Tights (any color)
 - Skirt (optional)
 - Pink ballet shoes
 - o Black tap shoes
- Ballet/Jazz Classes
 - o Tight fitting top leotard, tank, shirt (any solid color)
 - Fitted bottoms leggings, shorts, skirt (any solid color)
 - Pink Ballet Shoes
 - o Tan Jazz Shoes
- Jazz/Lyrical Classes
 - Tight fitting top leotard, tank, shirt (any solid color)
 - Fitted bottoms leggings, shorts (any solid color)
 - Tan Jazz Shoes
 - Turners/Half-Soles/Twylas/Pirouettes (different names for the same type of shoe)
- 10th 12th Ballet Class
 - Leotard and Tights (skirt optional) OR Tight fitting tank and Leggings/Shorts (any solid color)
 - Pink Ballet shoes
- Hip Hop
 - o Comfortable clothing (no jeans or denim shorts)
 - Clean sneakers (studio only, non marking soles)
- Tap
 - Tight fitting top leotard, tank, shirt (any solid color)
 - o Fitted bottoms leggings, shorts, skirt (any solid color)
 - Black tap shoes
